

Boundary Commission for Scotland Review of Scottish Parliament boundaries – Shetland Islands Council area

After the current review, Shetland Islands Council area will continue to form a county constituency for the Scottish Parliament:

Constituency	Designation	Electorate	Description
Shetland Islands	County Constituency	17,270	The entire Shetland Islands Council area

The Commission proposes that this constituency be combined with other constituencies as listed in the table below to form a Scottish Parliament region:

Region	Electorate	Description
Highlands and Islands	388,990	The constituencies of Argyllshire and Bute; Caithness, Sutherland and Ross; Dumbarton; Inverness and Nairn; Moray; Na h-Eileanan an Iar; Orkney Islands; Shetland Islands; Skye, Lochaber and Badenoch.
