

Boundary Commission for Scotland Review of Scottish Parliament boundaries – Stirling Council and Clackmannanshire Council areas

The Boundary Commission for Scotland has reviewed its provisional proposals for Scottish Parliament constituencies in the light of all representations received and Local Inquiries held. The Commission has decided to amend the boundaries of the constituencies in these council areas from its provisional proposals. The Commission's revised recommendations are:

Constituency	Designation	Electorate	Description
Clackmannanshire and Dunblane	County Constituency	49,470	The entire Clackmannanshire Council area; Stirling Council electoral ward 3
Stirling	County Constituency	52,480	Stirling Council electoral wards 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7

The Commission also proposes that these constituencies be combined with other constituencies as listed in the table below to form a Scottish Parliament region:

Region	Electorate	Description
Mid Scotland and Fife	490,700	The constituencies of Clackmannanshire and Dunblane; Cowdenbeath; Dunfermline; Kirkcaldy; Mid Fife and Glenrothes; North East Fife; Perthshire North; Perthshire South and Kinross-shire; Stirling.
